



INTRODUCTION

AIA Blue Ridge seeks nominations for architectural works of enduring significance that continue to make a contribution to the built environment in our region. Buildings awarded the Test of Time designation will be advanced by AIA Blue Ridge for consideration at the state level by AIA Virginia. Eligibility conditions:

1. The period of time for which the project must have endured the “Test of Time” shall be not less than 25 years nor more than 50 years from the date of initial construction.
2. The project may be a single structure or group of buildings forming a single project.
3. The project should still carry out the original program in a substantial manner (i.e. residential, place of assembly, institutional, education, etc.). The project must be standing as originally designed in appearance and in good condition.
4. The project must be located in AIA Blue Ridge region.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In a single PDF file, not more than 20 pages and not more than 15 MB, compile the following:

- Nominator’s statement: The statement should be no more than a paragraph and should include a concise description of the structure and summarize how it meets the criteria for the award.
- Narrative information: This information should detail the structure’s qualifications for the award, citing specific examples.
- Images
- Endorsements
- Other pertinent data
