INTRODUCTION

AIA Blue Ridge seeks nominations recognizing the contributions of non-member individuals or organizations that have inspired, influenced, or complemented the architecture profession in our region through the practice of an allied profession, research, education, planning, legislation, architectural writing, the arts, or crafts. Potential nominees could include an artisan/craftsperson, author, civic activist, code official, educator, lawyer, legislator, planner, developer, philanthropist, preservationist, or anyone who has contributed to our profession and the built environment in a unique and meaningful way.

Honor Award recipients will be advanced by AIA Blue Ridge for consideration at the state level by AIA Virginia.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In a single PDF file of not more than 20 pages and not more than 15 MB, compile the following:

- Nominator's statement: The statement should be no more than a paragraph and should include a concise description of the applicant and summarize how the nominee meets the criteria for the award.
- Narrative information: This information should detail nominee's qualifications for award, citing specific examples related to evaluative criteria.
- Biographical information: This information should include education, professional history, volunteer efforts, and awards/recognition received by the candidate.
